#### HELPFUL HINTS

\*Call 1-877-488-2287 to schedule appointments.

The office is open M-F. 7:30-4:00.

\* Give lots of notice - requests are 'first come first served'. Schedule return appointments as soon as you get them.

\* Don't make medical appointments late in the day, or you may not have a ride home. Columbus appointments need to be arranged so that you are back in town by 4:00.

\* Calling to confirm is OK.

UCATS is a transportation service here in Union County for folks 60 and over who need to get to Medical Appointments, Community Meals, Work and Special Events.

UCATS coordinates about 100 trips per day through their dispatch office in Marysville and satellite office here in Richwood. UCATS like everyone else is affected by rising gas prices, and only 63% of costs are covered by outside funding. The other .75 cents per mile has to be picked up in fees and donations from clients.

UCATS service in a rural area like ours is a privilege. People who are otherwise homebound are extended a lifeline to independence and freedom.

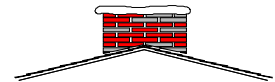
